This correspondence is in response to your request for an extension of the right-of-entry for the construction of a Desalination Plant and supporting infrastructure on Fort Bliss, Texas. Under the authority granted to the Department of the Army, pending relocation in support of the Texas Department of Transportation Inner Loop and consummation of the easement, I do hereby grant to the city of El Paso an extension on the right-of-entry upon the installation to complete construction on the property as outlined in the original right-of-entry.

This right-of-entry shall expire upon execution of the easement described above, but in no instance shall the term of this right-of-entry exceed one year from the date of its execution. This right-of-entry is revocable at will by the Department of the Army.

If this right-of-entry extension is acceptable under these conditions, request that your acceptance be shown by execution of both originals of this agreement.
